



Call for Proposals for Special Sessions

APCCAS 2014 strongly encourages the organization of Special Sessions to supplement regular programs, aiming to bring together leading researchers and practitioners from around the world to present their latest research in emerging topics of circuits and systems. Special Session proposals should cover topics that related to regular technical program of APCCAS 2014, but are not limited to them. All submitted papers go through the same review process, and decisions of acceptance will be based on the special session committee and the review results. The special sessions organizers and all invited speakers will be required to register for the conference.

Submission of Special Session Proposal

Proposals should include short summary with the following information:

- Name of the organizer(s) of the special session
- A title of the special session
- Session abstract (statement of the significance of the topic)
- Tentative titles and abstract of at least 5 invited papers
- List of names who have agreed to contribute a paper in the session
- Short biography of special session organizer(s) that includes complete affiliation, address and email
